On behalf of Chairman and Managing Director, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited, New Delhi wax / tape sealed tenders are invited from prospective Service Providers having minimum 2 (two) commercial vehicles either in his / her / company's own name or on lease hold (in case of a Travel agency) and any interested private individuals having commercially registered vehicles on or before the date of NIT of model not older than year 2010. Intending bidders may obtain Bid Document from SDE(General) O/o GMTD Dhenkanal on payment of Rs 563-00 (Rupees five hundred sixty three only, (non refundable) on all working days up to 17.00 hrs of Dt 23.05.2013 The payment will be accepted in the form of Cross Demand Draft drawn on any Scheduled Bank payable at Dhenkanal, in favour of Accounts Officer (Cash), BSNL, Dhenkanal. The Bidders shall have to deposit Rs. 6000-00 (Rupees Six thousand only) per Vehicle, as Bid Security or EMD in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Accounts Officer (Cash), BSNL, O/o GMTD, Dhenkanal, along with the Technical Bid.

N.B:- The G.M.T.D, Dhenkanal reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders in part or whole without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof.

Eligibility conditions:- bidder must submit attested/self attested /self attested /self attested copies of the following documents with the technical bid of the tender document:-

- (a) In case of Travel Agency, The bidder should have at least minimum 2 (two) commercial vehicles either in his / her / company's own name or on lease hold on or before the date of NIT of model not older than year 2010. Vehicles should be registered as commercial in his name or in name of company or lease holding for use as commercial as mentioned in preceding sentence. The proof of ownership in respect of commercial vehicles either owned or on lease must be submitted along with the Technical bid.
- (b) In case of Travel Agency, The bidder should have a valid certificate of one year before the date of NIT from a competent authority of any unit of PSU / any Central Govt. Department / any State Govt. department or any reputed Private Ltd. Companies / Firms for having executed similar contracts of providing at least 02 (two), petrol/ diesel/ CNG driven commercial vehicles such as Non-AC Indigo or equivalent cars, Jeeps Sumo, Armada, Marshall, Bolero or equivalent etc.
- (c) Attested/self attested /self attested/self attested copy of firm registration, partnership deed in case firm is partnership firm and affidavit from notary in case of sole proprietary firm must be submitted. The copy of proof for applying to obtain the firm registration before the date of NIT may also be acceptable subject to the condition that the copy of firm registration must be supplied before execution of agreement with the concerned bidder otherwise his tender will be cancelled and his EMD or Bid Security will be forfeited.
- (d) Copy of PAN card.
- (e) Copy of valid service tax registration.
- (f) Affidavit issued by notary on stamp paper regarding declaration of no closed relative employed in BSNL.

SECTION - II SCOPE OF WORK

The Bidder is required to provide commercial vehicles fully conforming to RTA/RTO regulation along with the cost of fuel, driver, other running and repairing charges etc and carryout periodical maintenance and execute the work through their Supervisor.

The work consists of two parts namely **PLAN-1** and **PLAN-2** on Monthly Slab Rate & Daily Rate based on BSNL's requirement. However, this tender is floated for **PLAN -1** only for monthly hire slabs of upto 1000. 1500, 2000, 2500 & 3000 run KMs in a month.

(NOTE: The Bidders responding to this NIT may quote for PLAN-1 only. The Bidder is required to quote for Hiring slab of 1000. 1500, 2000, 2500 & 3000 KMs run in a month under PLAN-1. The bidder should also quote for the extra Km run beyond KMs slab in a month as rupees per KM, detention charges beyond duty hours as rupees per hour and for night halt charges as rupees per night halt).

As per contingent & occasional requirement for day to day work vehicles will be requisitioned. The Time-Km hire slab on which cars are required and the estimated number of days in a year. Such <u>daily</u> **hiring** is tentatively indicated below.

N.B. 2.CHOICE OF THE VEHICLES RESTS WITH BSNL DHENKANAL.

The Tables shown in PLAN 1&2 above are only indicative and for regular work. The actual deployment may vary from time to time depending on work schedule, company's policy, intensity of maintenance and interruption duties and developmental activities etc. The additional requirement for a short period to meet the 'Peak Operational requirement' if any on day to day basis is also to be met with at the same rate quoted for regular work. The number of such requirement is not anticipated in this tender but may not exceed 25% of the above estimated quantity.

SERVICE PROVIDER'S OBLIGATIONS

- 1. **Service to be provided** is to supply on demand the commercial vehicles with licensed drivers, registered as commercial vehicles on hiring basis for running within the jurisdiction of Dhenkanal SSA under G.M.T.D. Dhenkanal The essence of the contract is to provide Prompt, Punctual, Efficient, Safe, Courteous and Quality Service. The contractor (Employer) must pay to each and every motor driver (Skilled labourer) employed by him for each and every commercial vehicle on applicable daily minimum wages rates for skilled labourers as circulated from time to time by Dy. CLC (Central), Bhubaneswar so as to ensure the compliance of minimum wages Act 1948 by the concerned Contractor (Employer) in respect of his motor drivers or employees or labourers since it is a statutory obligations on the part of contractor (Employer) and its compliance is to be ensured by the BSNL, Dhenkanal as a Principal Employer.
- 2. **Quantity of Vehicles** to be hired under Plan-1 & Plan-2 are shown in the Scope of Work. However, BSNL shall place the order only as per the actual requirement from time to time from the empanelled transporters as per Section IV of tender document. The GMTD, BSNL, Dhenkanal reserve the right to increase or decrease the quantity of vehicles by 25%.
- 3. **Duty Hours of** vehicles are normally for ten hours per day on all working days of month except Holidays and rest days. However actual duty hours / days shall be specified by actual users of vehicle. In case of emergency the vehicle can be utilized in Sunday and rest days.
- 4. **Notice period for supply of vehicles** shall be one day in advance for Regular requirements. One hour in advance for additional requirement during office hours. Telephonic intimation shall be considered as notice.
- 5. **Reporting Place for vehicles** is within the jurisdiction of Dhenkanal SSA under G.M.T.D. Dhenkanal. Actual place of reporting shall be specified by users of vehicles.
- 6. **Counting of Distance** will be from the starting **point** of the user and closing at the point wherever user completes his / her travel. The distance covered per day between user delivery address and the garage/ normal parking place will be allowed on actual basis or 5 KMs whichever is less.
- 7. **Accuracy of Meters** will be checked periodically by any authorized officer of BSNL and reserves the right to get the meter calibrated or checked at any time at his sole discretion and in the event of any error/fault in the meter being noticed, the bill for the journey undertaken (including those undertaken earlier) would be adjusted, besides any other penal action as decided by BSNL, which may even lead to termination of Contract.
- 8. **Miscellaneous Conditions:-** Service Provider should comply with the following:
- (i) **Telephones-** Telephones, where requisition of vehicles can be conveyed all the 24 hrs. Telephone Numbers must be specified in the bid.
- (ii) **Identity Cards-** Proper Identity Cards after verifying the antecedents of his drivers' through Local Govt. offices

- (iii) **Documents of vehicles-** The attested/self attested copy of R/C Book and the Insurance policy of vehicles supplied under this contract should be submitted to the authorised person of the BSNL and will be subject to scrutiny. All the commercial vehicles should be insured.
- (iv) **Uniforms-** provide his employees uniforms as required under the rules which shall be worn by them all the time while on duty.
- (v) Statutory Requirements- In case of Travel Agency, It is desirable to have the Registration with EPF, ESI Code but if any of the one or two as above is not available with the bidder then the self certificate with reasons for their non-applicability should be submitted by the concerned bidder along with the technical bid. However, the submission of copy of valid labour registration certificate or valid labour license certificate alongwith the technical bid by the concerned bidder is a statutory requirement. The contractor (employer) must ensure to pay the minimum wages as applicable to respective motor drivers (Skilled labourers) as per rates decided from time to time by Dy, CLC (Central), Bhubaneswar as per minimum wages Act- 1948 since the same is statutory requirement. The contractor (employer) should enclose the copy of muster roll register in form V vide rule 26 (5), the copy of Register of wages in form -X vide rule -26(1), the copy of Register of overtime in form -IV vide rule -25(2), the copy of register of fines in form -I vide rule -21(4), the copy of register of deductions for damage or loss in form – II vide rule – 21 (4) and the copy of wage slips vide rule – 26(2)in respect of each and every motor driver (skilled labourer) alongwith the bills to BSNL, Dhenkanal to process for necessary payments etc.
- (vi) **Govt.Tax / Levy / Duty** other than Service Tax for plying the vehicles in Dhenkanal SSA will be borne by the Service Provider.
- (vii) **Parking / Toll Charges,** if any, may be claimed by Producing valid parking / Toll slips.
- (viii) **Drivers** attested/self attested copy of driving license (light motor vehicle)should be submitted during the contractual period.
- (ix) **Consumables** like lubricants, tyres, battery and repairs, maintenance, taxes, insurance, etc. will be to the Service Provider's liability.
- (x) **Assign** driving to only qualified experienced licensed drivers and also assume full responsibility for the safety and security of the officers/officials and store items.
- (xi) **Duty Slips** in duplicate copy to be printed and serially numbered by the Service Provider as per prescribed format of BSNL (**Annexure -6**) and should ensure that at the end of duty; the duty slips are completed and signed by the users.
- (xii) **Vehicles Up-keep** shall be in good condition along with good and clean Seat covers & curtains. Vehicles so hired may be inspected by a pre-designated committee of BSNL officers with reference to good/properly maintained vehicle including cabin, upholstery, seats etc.
- (xiii) **Multi-utility Purpose-** If the department wants to take some stores to be transported, those stores to be transported by MUV.

9. **Debarring Conditions:-**

i) No sub-contracting of the Service allotted is permissible by BSNL. The near relatives of all BSNL employees either directly recruited or on deputation are prohibited from participation in this tender.

- ii) The tampering of meter reading, vehicle usage timings, overwriting of Summary / log sheet and misbehavior of driver while on duty shall be viewed seriously, leading to even cancellation of contract.
- iii) Service Provider shall not engage any person below 18 years of age.

10 BSNL will not have obligation:-

- (i) No liability whatsoever for payment of wages/salaries other benefits and allowances to his personnel that might become applicable under any Act or Order of the Govt. in this regard and the Service Provider shall indemnify BSNL against any/all claims which may arise under the provisions of various Acts, Government Orders etc. and any breach of such laws or regulations shall be deemed to be breach of this contract.
- (ii) No direct or indirect liability arising out of such negligent, rash and impetuous driving which is an offence under section 29 of IPC and any loss caused to BSNL have to be suitably compensated by Service Provider.
- (iii) Not be responsible for theft, burglary, fire or any mischievous deeds by his staff.
- (iv) Service Provider shall be the employer for his workers and BSNL will not be held responsible fully or partially for any dispute that may arise between the service provider and his workers.

11. Penalty for breach of terms & conditions:

- (i) In case of break down, after it's reporting for duty, the vehicles will have to be replaced by same type immediately or not more than one hour. In case of non-availability of suitable vehicle a penalty upto Rs. 200/- may be imposed in addition to deduction on pro-rata basis for the period. If the number of break down exceeds three times in a month, a penalty of Rs.300/- per break down shall be imposed.
- (ii) The penalty for absence during extra Hour duty will be Rs.100 per occassion and for Temporary absence during duty hours without valid permission shall be Rs.75 per hour of absence.
- (iii) In case of non-availability of vehicles for any particular day penalty of Rs.500/- per day shall be imposed in addition to deduction of hire charges on pro-rata basis for the period.
- (iv) If the vehicle provided by the Service Provider is found to be not in good condition or without proper document; the vehicle may be rejected and sent back. No payment shall be made on account of such rejection. However in case of dispute the decision of G.M.T.D. Dhenkanal would be final.
- (v) Replacement of vehicle due to any reason should satisfy all tender conditions like paper documents and license, Tax, Registration etc.
- (vi) Should not refuse to provide vehicles against BSNL's requirement and on each refusal a penalty as given at item (iii) above will be deducted from the running bills besides any other action which may even lead to termination of contract.

(vii) Signing of integrity pact.

The successful tenderer shall be required to sign the integrate pact on a non-judicial stamp of Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty only) at his own cost as per the enclosed Proforma in **Section V(A)**. The integrity pact will be signed separately along with agreement.

SECTION – IV

GENERAL (COMMERCIAL) CONDITIONS

- **1.0 Bidder's Eligibility conditions:-** bidder must submit attested/self attested /self attested/self attested copies of the following documents with the technical bid of the tender document:-
- 1.1 In case of Travel Agency, the bidder should have at least minimum 2 (two) commercial vehicles either in his / her / company's own name or on lease hold on or before the date of NIT of model not older than year 2010. Vehicles should be registered as commercial in his name or in name of company or lease holding for use as commercial as mentioned in preceding sentence. The proof of ownership in respect of commercial vehicles either owned or on lease must be submitted along with the Technical bid.
- In case of Travel Agency, the bidder should have a valid certificate of one year before the date of NIT from a competent authority of any unit of PSU / any Central Govt. Department / any State Govt. department or any reputed Private Ltd. Companies / Firms for having executed similar contracts of providing at least 02 (two) , petrol/ diesel/ CNG driven commercial vehicles such as Non-AC Indigo or equivalent cars, Jeeps Sumo, Armada, Marshall, Bolero or equivalent etc.
- 1.3 Attested/self attested copy of firm registration, partnership deed in case firm is partnership firm and affidavit from notary in case of sole proprietary firm must be submitted. The copy of proof for applying to obtain the firm registration before the date of NIT may also be acceptable subject to the condition that the copy of firm registration must be supplied before execution of agreement with the concerned bidder otherwise his tender will be cancelled and his EMD or Bid Security will be forfeited.
- 1.4 Copy of PAN card.
- 1.5 Copy of valid service tax registration with upto date payment particulars.
- 1.6 Affidavit issued by notary on stamp paper regarding declaration of no closed relative employed in BSNL.
- 1.7 Affidavit issued by notary on stamp paper for declaration regarding not blacklisted firm and firm is not debarred.
- 1.8 Copy of valid labour registration certificate or valid labour license certificate must be submitted.
- 1.9 In case of Travel Agency, attested/self attested / self attested/self attested copy of Valid EPF & ESI Certificate, if applicable. If not applicable, then enclose self declaration with valid reasons that EPF and ESI is not applicable to his/her firm.

In case of self attested/self attested copies, the concerned bidder should produce original when called for by the committee.

2. Right to Accept or Reject:

BSNL shall not be bound to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to itself the right to accept or reject any bid or to accept whole or a portion of tender, as it may deem fit, without assigning any reason thereof and without incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) for the action of BSNL.

3. Bid Forms (Two Bid Format).

The tender should be submitted in **two covers**; <u>One</u> super scribing Technical Bid and <u>Second</u> Financial Bid and both the envelopes are in turn, be put in another envelope and this envelope should be superscripted "Tender for Hiring Vehicles". All the three envelopes are to be duly sealed. Technical Bid and Financial Bid shall be opened separately. No indication of the Prices will be made in the Technical Bid. The Tender should be addressed to "AGM (HR & Admn.), O/o GMTD, BSNL, Dhenkanal, 1st Floor BSNL Bhawan, Dakhinakali Road, Dhenkanal-759001".

- 3.2 Tender will be opened in the presence of Bidders present on the due date of **opening i.e. at**16.00 Hrs. on 24.05.2013 Technical Bids of the Tenders received will be opened on that day and the Sealed Financial Bids will be kept in BSNL custody. The Time, Date and Venue of the opening of FINANCIAL BIDS will be intimated only to those Bidders, whose Technical Bid is accepted after evaluation of details and documents furnished in **Annexure-2.** No correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Incomplete Tender or Tender in which both technical Bid and Financial Bid are found in the same envelope is liable to be rejected. All Columns should be furnished with relevant details and no column should be left blank.
- 3.3 Financial Bid of the selected bidders only will be opened.
- 3.4 Bidder shall furnish the documents as per Technical Bid Form at Annexure-2
- 3.5 Rates should be quoted as per the Schedule of Requirement & Hire Charges at **Section-V** and should be enclosed to Financial Bid Form at **Annexure-1**. The format for Financial Bid should not be changed in any manner. Addition / deletion / alteration of the text will automatically render the tender invalid and therefore, will be summarily rejected.
- 3.6 The duly filled tenders must be accompanied with a Demand Draft of Rs. 6000/-(Rupees Six thousand only) as Bid Security (EMD).
- 3.7 Tender should be submitted to "The AGM (HR& Admn), O/o GMTD, Dhenkanal, on or before 13.30 Hrs. of 24.05.2013.
- 3.8 The bidder is requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specification in the Bid documents. Failure to furnish all the information required as per Bid Documents or submission of the bids not substantially responsive to the Bid Documents in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the Bid.
- 3.9 A prospective bidder requiring any clarification on the Bid document shall notify the purchaser in writing. The purchaser shall respond in writing to any request for the clarification of bid document which it receives not later than 7 days prior to the date of opening of Tender.
- 3.10 At any time, prior to the date of submission of bid, BSNL may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification required by a prospective bidder, modify the bid documents by amendments.
- 3.11 The amendments shall be notified in writing to all prospective bidders and these amendments will be binding on them.
- 3.12 The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid.

 BSNL in no case be responsible for these costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. **Bid opening**

BSNL shall open the Technical bid cover containing documents detailed as per clause (3.4) in the presence of bidders or their authorized representative who wish to be present at the time of opening of bids on due date. Authorisation letter to this effect shall be submitted by the bidder before they are allowed to participate in bid opening (Format is given in **Annexure-5**). After scrutiny and evaluation of the Technical Bids, the BSNL will shortlist those who are eligible and the date of opening of Financial Bid will be intimated later on. The financial bid will be opened only in those cases that fulfill the eligibility conditions and furnish all documents as given in Technical Bid.

5. **Bid Evaluation**

- 5.1 **Financial Bids** shall be evaluated to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made whether documents have been properly signed and whether bids are generally in order.
- 5.2 If there is a discrepancy between words and figures the amount in words shall prevail. Prior to detailed evaluation, BSNL will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the bid document. A substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of bid documents without material deviation. A bid determined as substantially non-responsive will be rejected by BSNL.
- 5.3 The procedure adopted for comparison of substantially responsive bids shall be on **monthly cost of hire of the services for all types of vehicles in station wise** indicated in Scope of Work in **Section-II**, inclusive of all levies and charges as indicated in schedule at **Section V** of the bid document.

6. Award of Contract

BSNL shall consider placement of letter of intent to those bidders whose offers have been found technically, commercially and financially acceptable. The bidder shall within 2 weeks of issue of letter of intent, give his acceptance along with performance security in conformity with clause 18 of Section-IV and as per format shown in Annexure-4 of bid document.

7. **Right to vary quantities**

BSNL reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease upto 25% of the required quantity of services specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in hiring charges of the offered quantity and other terms and conditions.

8. Signing of Contract

- 8.1 Signing of Agreement shall constitute the award of hiring contract on the bidder.
- 8.2 Upon the successful bidder furnishing the Performance Security the BSNL shall discharge its bid security in pursuant to **clause 12.**

9. **Annulment of Award**

Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirement of **clause 8** shall constitute sufficient ground for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security in which event BSNL may make the award to any other bidder at the discretion of BSNL or call for new bids.

10. **Period of validity of bids**

- (i) The bid shall remain **valid for 150 days** after the date of opening of bids. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by BSNL as non-responsive.
- (ii) A bidder accepting the request of BSNL for an extension to the period of bid validity, in exceptional circumstances, will not be permitted to modify his bid.

11. Bid Price.

- 11.1 The supplier shall quote price as per schedule given in **Section V** for all types of Vehicles given in the schedule of requirement. The composite price should include all the type of Taxes, including service Tax etc, as applicable from time to time. However, the basic unit price needs to be individually indicated against the supply under the contract.
- 11.2 The price quoted by the bidder shall remain fixed during entire period of Contract & price variation / revision as per tender clause 23 will be applicable.

11.3 "Discount" or extra charges if any mentioned by the bidders shall not be considered unless these are specifically indicated in the price schedule.

12. Bid Security

- 12.1 Pursuant to clause 3.6, the bidder must deposit Rs. 6,000/-(Rupees Six thousand only) per vehicle as Bid Security. The Bid Security shall be in the form of Demand Draft may be submitted in separate cover.
- 12.2 The successful bidder's security will be discharged upon the bidder's acceptance of the award of contract satisfactorily in accordance with **clause 18 of Section-IV** and furnishing the performance security.

13. The Bid Security may be forfeited:

- 13.1 If bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity specified by the bidder in the bid form.
- 13.2 If the successful bidder fails
- i) to sign contract in accordance with clause 08
- ii) to furnish performance security in accordance with clause 18 of Section IV
- iii) A bid not secured in accordance with para 11.1 shall be rejected by the BSNL as Non-responsive at the bid opening state and returned to the bidder unopened.
- iv) The bid security of unsuccessful bidder will be discharged / returned as early as possible but not later than 30 days after the expiry of the period of bid validity.

14. Terms of Payment:

- 14.1 The payment shall be made within 30 working days from the date of receipt of bill in the office of the **user of the vehicle.** Monthly bills i.r.o vehicles engaged on monthly basis or daily basis shall be submitted in triplicate to the authority specified in contract along with completed duty slips duly signed by the user by the 5th of the following month for payment. The copy of Service Tax paid Challan for the previous month / quarter as the case may be should be produced along with the bills for payment. In case, the bills are not submitted to BSNL as per above schedule, it will not take responsibility for delay in payment.
- 14.2 The triplicate copy of the bill will be returned to the Service Provider duly receipted. The bills should be sent to BSNL for payment vehicle-wise. It should be ensured that there is no overwriting in the duty slips. In no case, duty slip without signature will be accepted for payment and if it is found so, the amount will be disallowed.
- In case the vehicle engaged on monthly basis is to be discontinued during the month, the bill is paid on actual basis, as per terms & conditions.

15. Clause by clause compliance.

A clause- by - clause compliance of service to be provided shall be given as per Scope of Work U/S II and General & Commercial Conditions U/S-III. In case of deviation a statement of deviation shall be given.

16. Duration / Period of Contract:

Normally contract will be awarded for 1 (one) year. However, extension for the next year/part thereof will be considered keeping in view the various factors, such as prevailing market price, satisfactory performance of the firm.

17. Variation in tender cost- BSNL reserves the right to enhance the tender cost upto 25% and upto 50% in emergent case only.

Performance Security:

- 18.1 The successful bidder shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 10% of the contracted value within 2 weeks of conveying BSNL's intention for accepting the bid as Performance Security or The contractor shall permit the BSNL at the time of making any payment, to deduct an amount equal to 7.5% from each bill as performance security. In such case the successful bidder's bid security will compulsorily be converted to part performance security deposit.
- 18.2 Performance Security shall be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee/FDR/DD issued by a scheduled Bank valid for at least 18 months from the date of Agreement and the Performa provided in **Annexure-4** of the bid document.
- 18.3 Performance Security will be discharged after completion of Service Provider's performance obligations under the contract.
- 18.4 If the Service Provider fails or neglects any of his obligations under the contract it shall be lawful for BSNL to forfeit either whole or any part of performance security furnished by the bidder as compensation for any loss resulting from such failure.
- 18.5 EMD of successful bidder may be converted in to Performance security deposit.

19. Termination of Contract

- 19.1 In case of any default by the Service Provider and in any of the terms & conditions (whether General or Special), BSNL may without prejudice to any other right/remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter, terminate the contract, in whole or in part, by giving 2 clear working days notice in writing to the Service Provider.
- 19.2 All instructions, notices and communications etc. under the contract given in writing and if sent to the last known place of business, shall be deemed to be served on the date, even in ordinary course of post, these would have been delivered to the Service Provider.
- 19.3 Notwithstanding anything contained herein, BSNL also reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time or stage during the period of contract, by giving ONE WEEK NOTICE in writing without assigning any reason and without incurring any financial liability whatsoever to the Service Provider.

20. Termination for insolvency

BSNL may also by giving written notice and without compensation to the Service Provider terminate the contract if the Service Provider becomes unwilling, bankrupt or otherwise insolvent without affecting its right of action or remedy as hirer.

21. Insurance

The Insurance cover protecting the agency against all claims applicable under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1948 shall be taken by the Service Provider. The Service Provider shall arrange necessary insurance cover for any persons deployed by him even for short duration. BSNL shall not entertain any claim arising out of mishap, if any, that may take place. In the event of any liability/claim falling on BSNL, the same shall be reimbursed /indemnified by the Service Provider.

22. Prices:

- 22.1 The rates should be on monthly basis as well as daily basis. The KM slabs for monthly hire and Time-KM slabs for daily hire are shown in **Scope of Work in Section-II.** The rate for extra per Hour detention and extra per km running is to be indicated in both the cases.
- 22.2 Rates charged by the Service Provider for the services given under the contract shall not be higher than the rates quoted by the Service Provider in his bid. In case of any reduction of taxes and statutory levies (if any) during the contractual period, BSNL shall take the benefit of decrease in such taxes/ duties for the services to be availed from the date of enactment of revised duties/ taxes.
- 22.3 In case of increase in taxes/ duties during the contractual period, BSNL shall be liable to revise the rates as per new taxes/ duties for the services to be availed for the remaining period of the contract.

23. Price Revision:

23.1 No escalation is admissible on any account whatsoever during the first three months of the contract. After three months of contract increase or decrease in hire charges due to variation in Fuel rates will be worked out and paid only when the variation to base rate is above 10%. Such increase or decrease in the hire charges due to these variations shall be worked out from the base rate on the following formula:

Increase or decrease in Petrol/Diesel during the month =

Actual KMs run by the vehicle X (Revised rate per litre - Base rate per litre)

Average KM per litre of Diesel / Petrol consumption (KMPL)

(Note:- The Base Rate of Petrol/Diesel is the prevailing rate on the date of commencement of work / contract. The Average KMPL is to be assumed as 10 Kms in case of AC cars and 12 Kms in case of Non-AC Cars and Jeeps in both Petrol & Diesel driven. If there is decrease in Fuel Price, formula will indicate negative figure which means the deduction shall be done from the bill)

- 23.2 The review for change in hire charges due to change in fuel rates shall be affected at the end of quarter, irrespective of start of contract i.e. on 31st March, 30th June, 30 Sept, and 31st December. The change in hire charges, if any, shall be applicable from the 1st day of next quarter. Base Rate of fuel would be fuel prices as on date of award of contract.
- 23.3 In case of minimum average run per litre of fuel (i.e Average KMPL) as assumed above is not achieved by any vehicle, then the extra cost of fuel consumed by the vehicle on the basis of actual KMPL of fuel will be deducted from the payment due for that vehicle.
- 23.4 The service provider shall submit supplementary bill for reimbursement towards increase in Fuel price on monthly basis without accumulation. This supplementary bill is to be supported with proof of fuel price prevailing on 1st of the month.

24. Miscellaneous Conditions:

- 24.1 BSNL reserves right to counter offer price against price quoted by the L1 bidder.
- 24.2 More than one bidder will be engaged as per requirement at the L1 rate.
- 24.3 In case the date fixed for opening of bids is subsequently declared as holiday by the Government of India, the revised schedule will be notified. However, in absence of such notification, the bids will be opened on next working day, time and venue remaining unaltered.
- 24.4 BSNL reserves the right to disqualify such bidders who have a record of not meeting contractual obligations against earlier contract entered into with BSNL and blacklist such bidder / bidders for a suitable period in case they fails to honour their bid without sufficient ground.

25. Force Majeure:

If any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any war, or hostility, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God (Hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happenings, of any such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such events be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such on performance or delay in performance under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such an event

may come to an end or cease to exist, and the decision of BSNL as to whether the supplies have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days either party may, at his option terminate the contract

26 Arbitration:

26.1 In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under the agreement or in connection there with (except as to the matters, the decision to which is specifically provided under this agreement), the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of CGMT of Bharat Sanchar Nigam limited (BSNL) CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar or any other person appointed by him. In case his designation is changed or his office is abolished then in such case to the sole arbitration of the officer for the time being entrusted whether in addition to the function of the CGMT of Bharat Sanchar Nigam limited (BSNL) CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar or by whatever designation such officers may be called (hereinafter referred to as the said officer). In the event of such Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred to vacates his office on resignation or other wise or refuses to do work or neglecting his work or being unable to act as Arbitrator for any reasons whatsoever, the CGMT of Bharat Sanchar Nigam limited (BSNL) CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar of BSNL shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator in the place of outgoing Arbitrator and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed further with the reference from the stage at which it was left by the predecessor and that the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. Service Provider will have no objection in any such appointment that arbitrator so appointed is an employee of BSNL or a Government Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as a BSNL employee he has expressed his views on all or any of the matters in dispute. The adjudication of such Arbitrator shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitrator and Conciliation Act 1996, or any statutory modification or re-enactment three of or any rules made thereof.

The venue of Arbitration proceeding shall be Office of CGMT of Bharat Sanchar Nigam limited (BSNL) CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar or such other place as the arbitrator may decide.

26.3 The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of both the parties enlarge the time frame for making and publishing the award. Subject to aforesaid arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under, any modification thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.

27. Set Off (Recovery of Sum Due):

- 27.1 Any sum of money due and payable to the Service Provider (including security deposit refundable to him) under this contract may be appropriated by BSNL and set off the same against any claim of BSNL for payment of a sum of money arising out of this contract or under any other contract made by Service Provider with BSNL.
- 27.2 In the event of said security deposit being insufficient, the balance of total amount recoverable, as the case may be shall be deducted from any sum due to the Service Provider under this or any other contract with Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited. Should this amount be insufficient to cover the said full amount recoverable, the Service Provider shall pay to Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited on demand the balance amount, if any, due to Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited within 30 days of the demand by BSNL.

- 27.3 If any amount due to the company is so set off against the said security deposit, the service Provider shall have to make good the said amount so set off to bring the security deposit to the original value immediately by not later than 10 days.

This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- (b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s).will not commit any offence under the relevant Anti-corruption Laws of India; further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- (c)The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s? will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- (2) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3 - Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s). before contract award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder (s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the defined procedure.

Section 4 - Compensation for Damages

- (i) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3. the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security.
- (ii) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor the amount equivalent to Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee in addition to any other penalties/ recoveries as per terms and conditions of the tender.

Section 5 - Previous transgression

- (i) The Bidder declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in any country conforming to the Anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process
- (ii) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken as per the defined procedure

Section 6 - Equal treatment of al Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- (i) The principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders/Contractors.
- (ii) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment- in conformity with this Integrity Pact.
- (iii) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7 - Criminal charges against violating Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s)

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Corporate Vigilance Office.

Section 8 - External independent Monitor/Monitors

- 1. Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor' is to review independently and objectively whether and to what extern the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement
- 2. The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the CMD of the BSNL.
- 3. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all Project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Section, the 3idder(s)/Contractor(s) shall have no obligation whatsoever to provide any internal! costing mechanisms or any internal financial or commercial data pursuant to any audit or review conducted by or on behalf of the Principal. Further, the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall not be required to provide any data relating to its other customers, or any personnel or employee related date.
- 4. The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- 5. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 6. The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairperson of the Board of the Principal within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the 'Principal' and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 7. If the Monitor has reported to the CMD of the BSNL, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant Anti-Corruption Laws of India, and the BSNL has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Corporate Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.
- 8. The word "Monitor would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 - Pact Duration

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded. If any claim is made/ lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by CMD, BSNL.

Section 10 - Other provisions

- 1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. New Delhi The arbitration clause provided in the tender document / contract shall not be applicable for any issue /dispute arising under Integrity Pact.
- 2. Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing.
- 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4. Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intensions

- 4. The Service Provider agrees with the BSNL and with each authority competent to order that every contract of hire order should be subject to the terms of this Agreement for vehicle Hire and in the event of a conflict between these terms and the terms in hire order, the terms of this Agreement for vehicle Hire shall prevail.
- 5. Service Provider will provide vehicles to BSNL not older than 2010 model and registered for the commercial purpose only and taxes; insurance etc. due on such vehicles shall be the liability of the Service Provider.
- 6. The Service Provider should provide the particular make & model of vehicle as agreed upon in the contract. The BSNL only reserves the right to substitute it with another similar vehicle. If for any reason whatsoever the BSNL is not happy with the condition of the vehicle provided, the Service Provider's nearest office will be informed immediately and they should accept any liability to replace it as per requirement. If for any reason the Service Provider is not in a position to provide a substitute vehicle as demanded by the BSNL then the BSNL will be free to engage a vehicle from the open market and debit the expenditure on account of it on the claims payable to the Service Provider
- 7. Service Provider will submit bills in accordance with Section-IV, Clause (14) of the Bid document to the ______ Section of ______, of BSNL on monthly basis for release of payment by BSNL.
- 8. The driver of the vehicle shall always hold a valid Photo Identity Card issued by the BSNL Office or any other local Central / State govt. office competent to issue such cards as per Section-III, clause 8(ii) and also carry duty slips printed by the Service Provider as per the Format prescribed by BSNL, where the date, time, KMs reading, purpose and places visited are to be filled in and signed by the Users / BSNL officials. On the basis of these duty slips, the bills shall be raised to BSNL by the Service Provider. Counting of distance will be from the starting point of the user and closing at the point wherever user completes his / her travel. The distance covered per day between user delivery address and the garage/ normal parking place will be allowed on actual basis or 5 KMs whichever is less.
- 9. If the Service Provider fails to provide the vehicle to BSNL and if the service is not found satisfactory enough, the BSNL shall have the right to terminate the contract in whole or part as per clause (18) of Section IV of Bid Document.
- 10. In the event of any mechanical failure/breakdown of vehicle after it's reporting for duty, the Service Provider shall arrange for replacement by another Commercial Vehicle. Non-compliance may attract penalty as per Clause (11) of Section III of Bid Document.
- 11. The following penalties will accrue to the Service Provider in addition to the deduction on hire charges on pro-rata basis in the Plan-1. The penalty amount shall be deducted from the running bills besides any other action which may even lead to termination of contract:-
- 11.1.1 Non-availability or refusal of vehicles as requisitioned by BSNL for whatsoever reason under this contract shall invite penalty of Rs.500 per occasion.

- 13. The Bid Document No. NIT No : G-127/2012-13/03,Dtd. 15.04.2013, schedules annexure/appendix which we annexed to this agreement, as schedule "B" & ______ respectively shall form part and parcel of this Agreement and integral part of this agreement.
- 14. That Service Provider is/ shall be liable for any legal dispute/cases/claims that have arisen or may arise during the currency of the agreement in respect of vehicles provided by Service Provider. BSNL shall not be liable for any loss, damages, etc suffered/ to be suffered by Service Provider or third party as the case may be.

The Service Provider shall also be liable for all fines, penalties, and the like of parking, traffic and other criminal offences arising out of or concerning the use of the vehicle during the hire period and any toll Charges or entry Taxes payable locally and the Service Provider accordingly indemnifies the BSNL against all such liability.
- 17. The Service Provider shall not act as a broker for other hire companies or any individual or transfer or assign or sub-let any part of the service once agreed or any share of interest in any manner or degree, directly or indirectly, to any third party whatsoever and the contract will be valid only if the company signing the contract supplies the vehicles themselves from their own or leased fleet.
- 18. The Service Provider will also ensure that they will not supply the vehicles to BSNL which are either owned by employees of BSNL either directly recruited or on deputation to BSNL or their near relatives as defined in Sch-IA of Company Act 1956 and clause (9.i) of Section-III of the Bid documents enclosed as schedule "B" to this agreement. A certificate to this effect is annexed to this agreement as Appendix-IV.
- 19. The Service Provider will not be tampering the meter reading, vehicle usage timings, overwriting of Summary / log sheet and allow misbehavior of driver while on duty. Such incidents shall be viewed seriously, leading to cancellation of contract.
- 20. Service Provider shall not engage any person below 18 years of age.
- 21. Rates charged by the Service Provider for the services given under this contract shall not be higher than the rates quoted by the Service Provider in his bid and will be regulated by clauses (21 & 22) of Section-IV of Bid Document. The revision of rates may be allowed on account of increase or decrease in price of Petrol/Diesel/CNG and these variations shall be worked out from the base rate as per formula indicated in Clause (22.1) of Section-IV of Bid Document.

- 22. The KMs not used during a particular month in Plan-1 (monthly KMs slab) shall be carried over to the subsequent two months and extra KMs if any traveled during these two months will be adjusted against these unused KMs.

In case his designation is changed or his office is abolished then in such case to the sole arbitration of the officer for the time being entrusted whether in addition to the function of the CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar or by whatever designation such officers may be called (hereinafter referred to as the said officer). In the event of such Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred to vacates his office on resignation or other wise or refuses to do work or neglecting his work or being unable to act as Arbitrator for any reasons whatsoever, the CGMT, Odisha Telecom Circle, Bhubaneswar of BSNL shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator in the place of outgoing Arbitrator and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed further with the reference from the stage at which it was left by the predecessor and that the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. Service Provider will have no objection in any such appointment that arbitrator so appointed is an employee of BSNL or a Government Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as a BSNL employee he has expressed his views on all or any of the matters in dispute.
