CORRIGENDUM

As approved by the competent authority, the following corrigendum made vide limited tender bearing NIT No. PLG/PP ITI /2020-21/Part-I 23.08.2021 for repairing of faulty Modules of SMPS Power Plant (ITI only) in Cuttack Telecom District due to administrative reason.

Section-1 clause-10 (newly clause added) of original NIT

Restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017 on grounds of Defence of India and national Security.

Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the competent Authority as per OMs No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July, 2020 & 24th July, 2020 of Public Procurement Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance imposing restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs) 2017 on the grounds of Defence of India and National Security (Pl refer the OMs N.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July, 2020 & 24th July, 2020). For details please refer clause 2.2 under Section-4 Part-A. Bidders complying this order in all respect only will be considered for placing orders. Non compliance of this order will result in rejection of bid at evaluation stage itself. An undertaking is to be submitted by the bidder on the Bidder Company's letterhead (in Original) as per the Proforma at Section – 19

SECTION-4 clause-26 (newly clause added)

2.2 Restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs) 2017 are detailed below:

I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority, and such bidder(s) should have valid registration (in pursuant Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rule (GFRs) 2017) at the time of submission of bids and at the time of acceptance of bids.

II. "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', " consultant" or 'service provider in certain contexts) for the above purpose means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated herein before, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.

III. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means

a. An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or

- b. A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a Country; or
- c. An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- d. An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e. An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f. A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

IV. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:

1. In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.

Explanation

a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent of shares or capital or profits of the company;

b. "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decision including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements'

2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;

3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profit of such association or body of individuals.


4. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;

5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

V. An Agent is a person, employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.

VI. The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority (This is applicable for tenders of Works contracts, including Turnkey contract). VII. Bidder is required to submit certificate as under in compliance with the order on restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs) 2017.

All other terms and conditions of the tender is unchanged.
