- 3. (d) In case of any correction/addition/alteration/omission is found in the original tender document; the tender bid shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be rejected.
- 4.(a) The bidder should have experiences in providing skilled or unskilled or both manpower in BSNL/MTNL/Other PSUs/Central Govt. of <u>Rs.10 Lakhs taken together during the financial years</u>, <u>2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18</u>. Experience certificate in this regard is to be issued by an officer not below the rank of <u>Deputy general manager or equivalent</u>. Experience certificate issued by an officer not below the rank of DGM / TDM will be considered.
- 4. (b) The documents as listed out in Section VII should be uploaded in the E-Tender Portal.



1. The rate of per day wages during the period of contract will be as per the rates communicated by the Dy. Chief Labour Commissioner (C), Bhubaneswar from time to time.

2. The Employers (Contractor's) share of EPF contribution and Employer's (Contractor's) share of ESI contribution to be paid to the contractor (Bidder) will be based on the rates referred to at Note-1 above.

3. The Employer's (Contractor's) share of service charge for providing per day per labourer will be in percentage rate of amount of wages per day (rural areas) as on 01.10.2018 and as mentioned in column No.3 against Sl. No-1 of the above table. The above mentioned amounts shown under No.3 against Sl. No.1, 2 & 3 of above table and approved L-1 percentage service charges of the successful bidder against Sl.No.4 for this tender will be allowed to change automatically w.e.f 01.10.2018 to 31.03.2019 and w.e.f. 01.04.2019 onwards strictly in accordance with per day wages as to be revised and decided by Dy. Chief Labour Commissioner (C), Bhubaneswar.

SECTION - IV

SAFETY, SECURITY AND OBSERVANCE OF LABOUR LAWS:

1). The contractor will be responsible for the safety and security of labour employed by him for execution of the work. He will be required to insure each labourer as per labour laws. The contractor will ensure safe working by observing proper safety precautions.

2). The contractor will be required to abide by the labour laws enacted from time to time by the central or state govt. Maintenance and observance of any or all of the statutory labour laws will be the sole responsibility of the contractor. The claims arising out of injury, causality or anything else to the worker/labourer employed by the contractor will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

3). The payment should be made as per the labour laws subject to maximum number of working days in a calendar month.

4).Under the provisions of the workmen's compensation Act, in case any compensation is paid by BSNL to a workman/labourer employed by the contractor in execution of the work the same will be recovered from the contractor either from the bill preferred by him or by adjustment from his security deposit money.

5). Before commencement of work, the contractor should obtain a valid license by virtue of the provisions of the Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act. 1970 and of the Contract Labour Regulation & Abolition contract Rule, 1971 and continue to have valid license during the period of contract. The contractor shall be responsible for any contingency arising out of his failure to obtain and have a valid license.

6). The contractor should ensure that no labourer below the age of eighteen years is employed by him on the work.

7). The wages paid by the contractor to the labourer employed by him should not be less than the fair/minimum wages as defined in the CPWD contractor's labour regulation or as per the provision of Central Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Rules, 1971, whichever is applicable.

8). Under the provision of minimum wages Act.1948 and the minimum wages (central Rules), 1950, the contractor should allow the labourers employed by him on work one day rest against six days continuous work.

9). The contractor shall maintain "Muster Roll" in respect of all workmen employed by him on the work in contract from XVI of the CL (R&A) Rules, 1971.

10). The contractor should comply with all the rules framed by the Government from time to time for the protection of health and sanitary arrangement for workers employed by him.

11). The contractor shall maintain a Register of persons employed on work on contract in from XII of the C.L (R & A) Central Rules, 1971.

12). The contractor should carry out the work in such a manner that it will cause minimum hindrance to the traffic.

13). The contractor shall maintain register of accidents, in such form as may be convenient at the work place. Also other necessary registers are to be maintained by the contractor for labourers employed by him.

14). The contractor shall allow inspection of all the prescribed labour records to any of his workers or to his agent at a convenient time and place, after due notice is received or to the labour officer or to any other person authorized by BSNL on its behalf.

15). The contractor shall before commencement/commences his work on contract, display and correctly maintain and continue to display and correctly maintain in a clean and visible condition in conspicuous place of work, notices in English and in the local Indian languages spoken by majority of workers, giving the minimum rates of wages fixed under the minimum wages Act, the actual wages being paid, the hours of work for which such wages and other relevant information.

16). The contractor shall submit periodical returns as may be required / prescribed from time to time.

17). The labours engaged by the contractor will not claim any employment in the BSNL at any time in future. This should be clearly brought to the notice of the labourers / workers by the contractor.

Other terms and conditions :

- The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the right to increase / decrease the quantity of skilled casual labourer (Data Entry Operator) to be provided by the contractor against any respective site in charge as per operational requirement / financial constrains of the company in the field units from time to time even after award of contract. Further GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the right to withdraw any skilled labour (DEOs) with prior notice of 1 month inview of operational requirement.
- 2. The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserve the right to deploy or shift data entry operators under any site incharge within jurisdiction of GMTD, Dhenkanal as per operational need and duty hour of any skilled casual labourer (DEO) can be splitted as per operational requirement.
- 3. The contractor shall not assign or sublet the work to any other persons or agency.
- 4. BSNL is not liable to pay for additional works carried without prior sanction of GMTD, Dhenkanal
- 5. BSNL will not pay any advance of any kind.
- 6. Incase, any extra duty is required in any section for specific work, prior approval may be taken the field units and extra payment may be made for performing additional duty.
- 7. The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the right to award work to more than one contractor for different site in-charges in exigency of service.
- 8. All materials supplied to the bidder will always be the sole property of the BSNL even when they are under the safe custody of the bidder. Any damage or loss is to be made goods / properties by the skilled labourers will be paid by the contractor on actual cost basis.
- 9. The BSNL for execution of contract works will supply no manpower. The bidder should make his own arrangements for providing workmen required to respective site-in-charges
- 10. The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the right to impose any other conditions, if necessary, at any time during the validity period of the tender.
- 11. While carrying out work for any site-in-charges, the contractor should ensure least interruption to the working equipment and GMTD, Dhenkanal is empowered to cancel the tender or impose any penalty including forfeiture of performance security deposit of the contractor for not following the tender's terms-conditions at any time.
- 12. All the amenities to the skilled casual labourers (Data entry operators) such as drinking water, washing facilities etc. should be provided by the contractor at his own cost at the work spot as required under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970.
- 13. The contractor should take responsibility for safety of all his skilled casual workers (Data entry operators) and the BSNL will not be held responsible for any casualty during the execution of any kind of contract work.
- 14. The bidder will claim charges only for the number of skilled casual labourers(Data entry operators) applied by the contractor to concerned site-in-charge as permitted through this tender and payment will be made to the contractor every month through E-payment only, if the bills are found in order in compliance to all labour laws.
- 15. The person/persons deputed for the execution of job should have minimum working knowledge in the computer working field and should have good conduct and behaviors. If any irregularity or laxity in duty is noticed by the concerned site-in-charge who is the representative of BSNL(Site-in-charge), then the contractor is liable to withdraw such person(s) after receipt of one month notice from GMTD, Dhenkanal for withdraw of skilled labourer (Data entry operators).
- 16. Time Limit for Unforeseen Claim:-Under no circumstances whatsoever shall any claim for any compensation from the BSNL on any account be considered unless the contractor submit the claim in writing within one month from the date of the final payment of the bill for the works concerned.

SECTION-V

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS & GENERAL CONDITIONS OF TENDER INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

A) DEFINITIONS

- (a) **"The User"** means the GMTD, BSNL, Dhenkanal, Orissa Circle, acting on behalf of CMD, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited.
- (b) **"The Bidder"** means the individual or firm who participates in the tender and submits its bid.
- (c) **"The Contractor"** means the individual or firm providing data entry works under the contract.
- (d) **"The Service"** means the Data Entry work which the contractor is required to provide to the user under the contract.
- (e) "The letter of intent" means the intention of the user to place the work order on the bidder.
- (f) **"The work order"** means the order placed by the user on the contractor signed by the user including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein. The work order shall be deemed as "Contract" appearing in the document.
- (g) **"The Contract Price"** means the price payable to the contractor under the work order for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations.

B) SCOPE OF TENDER:

The scope of the tender is to provide **27 (twenty seven)** labourers (May increase or decrease with the discretion of the general manager of the District), to carry out the data entry and allied works for various activities as detailed in Section-II in various sections in O/o General Manager Telecom District, BSNL, Dhenkanal and other units under the GMTD's jurisdiction for maxim number of working days in a particular month which may vary from month to month. The selected bidder should be in a position to start similar type of new work as & when entrusted within 24 hours.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1(a) "BSNL" or "The Nigam" or "The Tendering Authority" means Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (A Govt. of India Enterprise) acting on behalf of the President of India and represented by the General manager Telecom District, Dhenkanal.
- 1(b) "The Bidder" means the individual or firm who participates in this tender & submits its bid.
- 1(c) "The Work Order" means the order placed by the BSNL on the Bidder signed by the Engineer- in-Charge of BSNL including all attachments & appendices thereto and all document incorporated by reference therein. The work shall be deemed as "Contract" appearing in the document.
- 1(d) "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the bidder under the work order for full & proper performance of its contractual obligations.
- 1(e) "Site Engineer" means the concerned Sub-Divisional Officer (Phones) or Sub-Divisional Officer (Telegraphs) or Accounts Officer in-charge of this Telecom District under whose zone the contractor will provide the requisite number of labourers on daily basis as per actual requirement of concerned respective site Engineer (Zone in-charge) varying from 1 (one) number to maximum number as mentioned against each Site Engineer under Section-II.

- 1(f) "Engineer In-Charge" means the controlling DE/AGM/CAO of respective Site Engineer of this Telecom District who is designated as the "Engineer in-Charge" of respective "Site Engineer" as mentioned in the Section -II.
- 1(g) "E-Tender Portal" means the website "www.tenderwizard.com/BSNL" of M/s ITI Limited who is providing e-Tendering solution to BSNL.
- 1(h) "ETS" means the Electronic Tendering System through the e-Tender Portal.

3A. GST Compliance

- (i) The bidder should submit valid GST regn certificate or mention as unregistered dealer as per GST act.
- (ii) A self declaration that the bidder is not blacklisted by GST authorities
- (iii) In case the supplied get blacklisted during the tenure of contract then any loss suffered by BSNL will be recovered from the bill / security money.
- (iv) If the bidder has multiple GST number then all such numbers will be provided.
- (v) The bidder should submit correct HSN / SAC codes, the bidder will be responsible for loss to BSNL owing to wrong furnishing of the HSN / SAC codes.
- (vi) The bidder should submit GST invoice / Debit & Credit Note as per rule.
- (vii) It would be responsible of the supplier to declare correct information of invoice and to file GST returns in time enabling BSNL to avail Tax credit. Any loss by BSNL for not complying GST provisions will be recovered from the bidder.

4. ELIGIBLE BIDDERS

The bidder should <u>have experiences in providing skilled or unskilled or both</u> <u>manpower</u> in BSNL/MTNL/Other PSUs/Central Govt. and must have carried out the said work to the tune of Rs.10 Lakhs taken together during the financial years 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18.

5. VALIDITY OFBID: The bid validity period is 180 days from the date of opening of bid documents.

If the work is awarded to more than one contractor the security amount as mentioned above will be divided among the number of contractors, on proportionate basis.

The security deposit (SD) is required to protect the BSNL against the risk of bidders conduct and will be forfeited in part / whole in case of -:

- a) Unsatisfactory service.
- b) Theft or misappropriation of articles of the BSNL by the Data entry operators provided.
- c) Damage caused to BSNL assets and damage/loss to store issued
- d) Withdrawal of the successful bidder from the contract before its expiry without giving proper notice as specified in the terms & conditions of this tender document.
- e) Or all or some of the above.

7. The conditional and incomplete tenders are liable for rejection.

8. The general manager, Telecom Dist, Dhenkanal reserves the right to reject one or all of the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

9. Transportation of labour from one site to another and from one town to other will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

10. The GMTD, Dhenkanal will not be responsible to provide residential accommodation to the labourers employed by the contractor. All arrangements in this regard, will be the responsibility of the contractor.

11. The near relative of employees of BSNL are prohibited from participation in this tender (either directly recruited or on deputation). The near relatives for this purpose are defined as, a) Members of Hindu undivided family. b) They are husband & wife, c)The one related to other in the manner as father, mother, son(s)& son's wife (daughter-in-law), daughter(s) & daughter's husband (son in law),brother(s) & brother's wife, sister(s) & sister's husband (brother-in-law). Declaration is available at Annexure-D of Section-VIII.

12. In case of any dispute arising out of the contract between the two contracting parties, the decision of the general manager, Telecom Dist. Dhenkanal shall be final and binding.

13. The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the rights to increase/decrease or delete the scope of work without assigning any reason thereof.

14. The works against this tender will be executed under the overall control of the general manager Telecom District, Dhenkanal.

15. COST OF BIDDING

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid. BSNL in no case be responsible for these costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

16. CLARIFICATION ON BID DOCUMENTS

- (a) A prospective bidder, requiring any clarification of the Bid Documents shall notify the Tendering authority in writing or FAX or at the Tendering authority's mailing address indicated in the NIT. The Tendering authority shall respond in writing to any request for clarification of the Bid Documents, which it receives up to 13:00 hrs of 20.02.2019 Copies of the query (without identifying the source) and clarifications by the Tendering authority shall be sent individually to all the prospective bidders who have received the bid documents.
- (b) Any clarification issued by BSNL in response to query raised by prospective bidders shall form an integral part of bid documents and it may amount an amendment of relevant clauses of the bid document.

17. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR BID

- The details of documents to be submitted through online in e-Tender Portal are as detailed at Section VII. If any one of the above items required to be submitted along with the Technical bid is found wanting, the offer is liable to be rejected at that stage.
- b. Documents in original should be submitted for verification as required by the Tendering Authority.
- c. The bidder will verify the genuineness and correctness of all documents and certificates including experiences/performance certificates, submitted by the bidder or any other firm / associates before submitting them in the bid. The onus of proving genuineness of the submitted documents would rest with the bidder.

d. As per the requirement of the tender's condition, if any documents/paper/certificate submitted by the bidder is found to be false/fabricated/tampered / manipulated at any stage during bid evaluation or after award of contract, then the bid security (EMD/PBG/TDR) of the bidder would be forfeited and the bidder would be disqualified from the tender. Action would be taken for banning of business dealing with the defaulting firm. In case contract has already been awarded to the bidder, then PBG would be forfeited and the contract would be rescinded / annulled and BSNL would be at liberty to procure the services from any other source at the risk and cost of the defaulting bidder. Action would also be taken for banning business dealing with the defaulting firm. An undertaking to this effect should be submitted by the bidder as per format at Annexure-M of Section-VIII.

18. AMENDMENT TO BID DOCUMENT

- (a) At any time, prior to the date of submission of bid, tendering authority may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification required by a prospective bidder, modify the bid documents by amendments.
- (b) The amendments shall be notified in the E-Tender Portal and these amendments will be binding on them.

19. PREPARATION OF BID DOCUMENTS - TECHNICAL BID & FINANCIAL BID

It is a two bid system and the bid prepared by the bidder shall comprise Technical Bid and Financial Bid and should be prepared as per Clause.31 of this Section.

20. BID FORMS

<u>The bidder shall fill in the tender document in all respects, sign on all pages along with seal of the firm if any and upload required scanned documents as per Section-VII of the same in e-Tender Portal.</u>

21. BID PRICE

The bidder shall quote rates in FINANCIAL BID given in Section VI.

22. COMPLIANCE

- (b) Prior to the detailed evaluation, the Tendering authority will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the Bid documents.

31. CONTACTING THE TENDERING AUTHORITY

(a) Subject to seeking clarifications on e-tendering and tender document, no bidder shall try to influence the Tendering authority on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening till the time the contract is awarded.

(b) Any effort by a bidder to influence the Tendering authority in the tendering authority's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions shall result in the rejection of the bid.

- viii. The contractor has to submit the payment challans of statutory dues, i.e., for GST, EPF, ESI, etc. along with the bill for the last month of the tender period in addition to other documents as mentioned above.
- ix. The copy of ESI card issued by ESIC branch office, Dhenkanal each labourer should be produced along with the 1st Bill submitted.

35. DISPUTES IN TENDER FINALIZATION:

In the event of any disputes arising out of finalizing of tender agreement or any other matter relating to this tender the decision of GMTD, Dhenkanal shall be final and binding on all concerned.

36. DISQUALIFYING CLAUSE:

The BSNL reserves the right to disqualify such bidders who have a record of not meeting the contractual obligations against earlier contracts entered into with the BSNL. The terms and conditions enumerated above shall be binding and the bidders shall have to accept them in writing along with tender. The GMTD, Dhenkanal reserves the right to vary the quantum of work against each respective zone as per actual requirement in the field from time to time.

37. The BSNL reserves the right to award work to more than one contractor in any Zone in exigency of service. However, the quantity of work may vary on contractor to contractor at any given point of time.

38. Termination of Contract by BSNL

(a) The GMTD, Dhenkanal may, at its option, cancel or omit the execution of one or more items of work under this contract and may part of such items without any compensation whatsoever to the contractor.

(b)BSNL may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract may terminate the contract in whole or in parts by giving one months notice in writing to the service provider if the contractor fails to execute the work assigned to him within the period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by BSNL.

(c) If the contractor fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Conditions of the contract.

(d)All instruction, notices & communication etc. under the contract given in writing and if sent to the last known place of business, shall be deemed to be served on the date, even in ordinary course of post ,these would have been delivered to the service provider.

(e)Notwithstanding anything contained herein, BSNL reserves the right to terminate the contract at any stage or time during the period of contract ,by giving one month notice in writing without assigning any reason and without incurring any financial liability whatsoever to the service provider.

(f)The GMTD, Dhenkanal may, at any time, at its option cancel and terminate this contract by written notice to the contractor, in which event the contractor shall be entitled to payment for the work done up to the time of such cancellation and a reasonable compensation in accordance with the contract prices for any additional expenses already incurred for balance work exclusive of purchases and/or while of material, machinery and other equipment for use in or in respect of the work.

(g)BSNL may also by giving written notice and without compensation to the contractor terminate the contract if the contractor becomes unwilling, bankrupt or otherwise insolvent without affecting its right of action or remedy as hirer.

39. Penalty Clause:

For delays in the contractor's performance:

- a The time allowed for completion of work as entered in the work order shall be strictly adhered to by the contractor and shall be reckoned from the seventh day from the issue of the work order by BSNL. The contractor shall pay as penalty amount equal to 2(two)% of the amount of the incomplete work for every one week of delay or part thereof in completion of work subject to a maximum of 10 % of the cost of the work awarded.
- b. On any date the penalty payable as above reaches 10% of the estimated cost of the work the contractor should proceed with the work further only on getting a written instruction from the concerned DE, that, he is allowed to proceed further with the work.
- c Penalty for delay in completion in work shall be recoverable from the bill of the contractor and/or by adjustment from the SD or from the bill of any other contract of BSNL.

40. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- (a). Bid shall remain valid for 180 days from date of opening of the bid. A BID VALID FOR A SHORTER PERIOD SHALL BE REJECTED BY BSNL AS SUBSTANTIALLY NON-RESPONSIVE BID.

If any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any war, or hostility, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God (Hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happenings, of any such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such events be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such no performance or delay in performance under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such an event may come to an end or cease to exist, and the decision of BSNL as to whether the works have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days either party may, at his option terminate the contract.

43. <u>Arbitration</u>:

a. In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under the agreement or in connection there with (except as to the matters, the decision to which is specifically provided under this agreement), the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of GMTD Dhenkanal or any other person appointed by him. In case his designation is changed or his office is abolished then in such case to the sole arbitration of the officer for the time being entrusted whether in addition to the function of the GMTD Dhenkanal or by whatever designation such officers may be called (hereinafter referred to as the said officer). In the event of such Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred to vacates

his office on resignation or otherwise or refuses to do work or neglecting his work or being unable to act as Arbitrator for any reasons whatsoever, the GMTD Dhenkanal of BSNL, Odisha shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator in the place of outgoing Arbitrator and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed further with the reference from the stage at which it was left by the predecessor and that the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. Contractor will have no objection in any such appointment that arbitrator so appointed is an employee of BSNL or a Government Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as a BSNL employee he has expressed his views on all or any of the matters in dispute. The adjudication of such Arbitrator shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitrator and Conciliation Act 1996, or any statutory modification or re-enactment there of or any rules made thereof.

44. Set Off:

The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant Anti-corruption Laws of India, further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.

(d). The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payment he has made, is committed to or intends to make agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.

(2) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outline above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3- Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s), before contract award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the defined procedure.

Section 4-Compensation for Damages

(i). If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled is entitled to demand and recover the damaged equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security.

(ii). If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor the amount equivalent to Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee in addition to any other penalties/recoveries as per terms and conditions of the tender.

Section 5- Previous transgression

(i). The Bidder declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last 3 years with any other company in any country conforming to the Anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.

(ii). If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken as per the defined procedure.

Section 6- Equal treatment of all Bidders/ Contractors/ Subcontractors

(i). The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders/ Contractors.

(ii). The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity

with this Integrity Pact.

(iii). The Principal will disqualify from tender process all bidders who do not sign this pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7- Criminal charges against violating Bidder(s) /Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s)

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor, Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor, Subcontractor, which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Corporate Vigilance Office.

Section 8- External Independent Monitor/ Monitors

- 1. Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligation under this agreement.
- 2. The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the CMD of the BSNL.
- 3. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the contractor. The contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s) /Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Section, the Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) shall have no obligation whatsoever to provide any internal costing mechanisms or any internal financial or commercial data pursuant to any audit or review conducted by or on behalf of the Principal. Further, the Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) shall not be required to provide any data relating to its other customer, or any personnel or employee related data.

- 4. The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meeting among the parties related to the project provided such meeting could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meeting.
- 5. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 6. The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairperson of the Board of the Principal within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the "Principal" and should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 7. If the Monitor has reported to the CMD of the BSNL, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant Anti-corruption Laws of India, and the BSNL has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the corporate Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.
- 8. The word , Monitor would include both singular and plural

Section 9- Pact Duration.

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.

Read, understood , complied & agreed

If any claim is made/lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by CMD, BSNL.

Section 10- Other Provisions

- 1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. New Delhi. The arbitration clause provided in the tender document/ contract shall not be applicable for any issue / dispute arising under Integrity Pact.
- 2. Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing.
- 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be, signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4. Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intensions.
